The Wii Bowling League is going strong and is a blast to watch. Come on out and watch for a good time. Check out the Legion website for our stats.

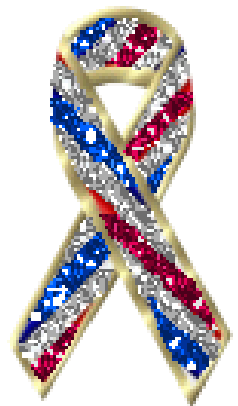
